	a) Website: The webmaster, Cllr Adams, delivered his
	report stating that it covered an 18-week period.
	Community website subscriptions are up and there
	were 4,800 views. Subscriptions to the Government
	website are still very low, although the main page
	being accessed is Meetings. Cllr Adams then
	announced that he is stepping away from the
	administration of the Government website and reported
	that he will hand over the day-to-day control of that site
	to Bev Fletcher, a resident of All Saints, following a
	period of training. The Chair thanked Ms Fletcher for
	taking on this important role and Cllr Adams for setting
	up both sites and administering them.

 New Environmental Policy: The Chair sought approval to adopt the new Environmental Policy.

c) Highways:

- (i) Progress with installation of VAS: The Clerk reported that there was still no information on when the VAS and poles would be installed. Cllr Hayward and Cllr MacKinder had both entered the fray and had contacted the relevant departments at DCC Highways and EDDC Property. The last information received by the Clerk was that the request had gone from Property to Housing. An email was received from Cllr Hayward to say that he had contacted the Director of Housing urging him to approve the installation of the pole in Goldsmiths Lane, without further delay.
- (ii) Speeding/Safety: The Clerk reported that she had finally managed to register with the Speedwatch Group and as soon as the application had been accepted, she would be in contact with the other residents who had volunteered to sign up.

d) Pavilion/Salisbury Diocese:

- (i) Progress on negotiations with Diocese to extend lease: Cllr Fletcher reported that trying to get hold of the Salisbury Diocese contact, was proving very difficult. However, he had been put in touch with a contact at Strutt & Parker, who had given the Parish Council permission to knock down the internal walls in the Pavilion which form the two changing rooms. Progress is slow as the discussions are more complex than the simple renewal of the existing lease.
- (ii) Working Group: Cllr Fletcher reported that a Working Party would be established, with Steve Keynes as the Project Manager, to remove the walls, as soon as this can be arranged.
- e) Flooding on the Cricket Field. The Clerk reported that two quotes had been received to unblock the pipe that is causing the flooding. After conversations with the Parish Council Lengthsman, it is proposed that a ditch

	be excavated from the top left-hand corner of the field, to the bottom left hand corner, where the water then goes through a pipe and out into the ditch on the road side. It was felt that this would be a better option as there would always be a risk the pipe would block up again. All Councillors agreed to this in principle and will investigate further. f) All Saints Parish Council Logo: The Chair sought approval to adopt the new logo and thanked Richard Greaves for his input. Proposed by Cllr Adams, Seconded by Cllr Verplancke. Unanimously Approved.
