

All Saints Parish P3 Report –March 3rd, 2026

This report is a summary of activity from January 2026 to March 2026. More details are available on request.

Prowler Days: 7

Heavy rain and high ground water has made some activities impossible.

Activity Highlights:

- Actions 1 & 2 below taken based on resident's reports that gates were not passable.
- 1. New hinges installed on metal field gate on Bridleway 38 (top of the Beacon on the Chardstock border). This is not strictly in our parish – but... no one else was going to do it!
- 2. Hinge pins removed and reinstalled on wooden field gate on Bridleway 38 (last gate before the Beacon). Both no.1 and 2 above meant the gates were not usable.
- 3. Surveyed damage near the junction of FP71 and FP61 in Smallridge. Created a mitigation plan.
- 4. Surveying for major and minor works
- 5. 7th January - Had positive response from DCC re. required supplies stating that supplies and a meeting would be imminent. We would visit their offices, meet and collect supplies.
- 6. Meeting with ASPC to discuss funding handling.

Activity Lowlight:

- Re. 5. Above – no further action from DCC since original response.

Paths and Bridleways visited: Many

Ongoing/Upcoming Projects:

- Re.3 above – planned work to start on Wednesday 11th March.
- Continue numbering project – Still only 7 footpaths to go!
- Restart strimming and trimming throughout the parish.
- Dig drainage for FP56 – waterlogging towards Heather Bell
- Replace finger post at School corner with AS41- awaiting supplies
- Replace finger pointer outside of Churchill Farm (damaged by hedge cutting) – awaiting supplies
- Various finger post repairs – awaiting supplies

Next Planned Prowler Day: Re.3 above - Wednesday 11th March
